- He's not willing to negotiate
- Was a teenage father, married & had another family after age 30
- Book by Paul Tough "Whatever It Takes"

Shanell contacted Robert Dugger; he hasn't responded yet

Beth Walling contacted Ron Lally, WestEd's Center on Family Studies

- Created PITC & 0 – 3, the organization that Beth works for
- Has done work in Italy; written several books; previous researcher
- He is available -- \$5,000, plus travel expenses
- Filming a documentary in Cedar Rapids, Chicago & DC

Would like to invite the Governor to come & speak

Sheila saw Ron Lally at 0 – 3 conference in LA – topic was resiliency & relationships; one of her favorite presentations

Mary suggested that Dr Anda's topic is very timely. She's heard a lot about increased abuse & referrals are up all over the state.

Tom suggested that we haven't had a speaker from the health arena for a long time; this could help bring health people back to the Congress.

Strong family support in both speakers – Anda & Lally

Mary questioned whether 0 – 3 teachers would feel that this focus included them.

Shanell suggested, if we could afford both, inviting Ron Lally to present in the evening, & possibly invite him to speak to a small target group earlier in the day  
Lally is one of the first people contacted to advise the President, and called on by Legislators.

It was decided that Lally would be our preference.
